## Privacy Notice (Regulation EU 2016/679 - "GDPR")

Pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679, this is to inform the person concerned of the purposes and methods for the processing of his/her personal data, the scope of communication and disclosure thereof, the nature of data in our hands and the supply thereof.

## Purposes of data processing

Data will be processed in order to: fulfil any formality required for selection procedures for admission to the academic year (including contacts, interviews, etc. by email, phone, fax, etc., assessment of applications, etc.); send invitations, notices and/or information about activities, courses, meetings, conferences, events, etc. organised by or on behalf of the European College of Parma Foundation and/or the Alumni Association. If the applicant is admitted, data will also be processed so as to: finalise the registration and fulfil any further formality that may be required or expedient for holding the course and any side activities and/or activities in support of the course (notices, certificates, agreements, attendance checks, exams, etc.), publish informative and promotional material for the European College of Parma Foundation and the Alumni Association.

Data processing methods: Data will be processed in a lawful and proper manner in accordance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679. Personal data will be processed by means of manual, IT or ITC media, with methods closely related to the aforesaid purposes, so as to ensure such data will be secure and confidential. Data will be stored on digital and/or paper media.

Scope of disclosure and communication: Data processing is carried out directly by the European College of Parma Foundation, through the persons expressly appointed/authorised for the purpose by the Controller. Within the scope of data processing purposes, if the applicant is admitted to the course, the applicant's personal data can be disclosed to third parties insofar as this may be needed to hold the course and related activities, such as: Professors, Tax firms & consultants and personnel management firms, Police authorities, Companies and Bodies working under agreements, Insurance and social security agencies, Insurance companies, Third parties for finalisation of agreements and the Foundation; public and private bodies to which communication is necessary in connection with the purposes of data processing, or required by the law, by a regulation or by EU legislation, and in any case due based on a legitimate order by the Authorities.

Nature of data supply and consequences of failure to provide data: The supply of personal data and any information in general is optional; refusal to provide such data and the requested information may however make it impossible to establish any relation with the European College of Parma Foundation.

Data disclosure: Personal data being processed will not be subject to disclosure; data will therefore not be revealed to undetermined subjects.

Data transfer: Personal data being processed will be transferred only towards EU Member States, and for institutional communication purposes.

## Rights of the data subject - GDPR 2016/679

The data subject is entitled to exercise his/her rights as provided under Regulation (EU) 2016/679, Sections 2 and 3, i.e.:

- to know what personal data is processed by the Foundation, the source of such data, as well as the purposes and methods of processing (Art. 15 GDPR 2016/679);
- to request the rectification of data from the Holder of the data processing (Art. 16 GDPR 2016/679);
- to request the erasure of personal data concerning him or her ("right to be forgotten") being processed by the Controller of the data processing (Art. 17 GDPR 2016/679);
- to request restriction of processing of data (Art. 18 GDPR 2016/679);
- to object to processing of data if processing lies within the cases described under Art. 21 GDPR 2016/679.
- to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (Articles 13-14 GDPR 2016/679).

**Duration of processing:** Data will be processed for a length of time that does not exceed the necessary time for the purposes for which data has been collected. However, if the data subject deems, for any reason, that data are no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which they were collected, he/she shall inform the below-specified Controller thereof in writing, and the Controller shall proceed immediately to erase the information.
